

## Worksheet 7

**Topic 7: Understanding the functionality of HTML**

1. Write the HTML using a text editor to create a web page like this:

**Hello World!**

This is my first HTML page

2. Add the following to the head section of the HTML page you have created:

- Set the title to 'IAL - Unit 2'
- Set the language to English
- Set meta data for the page, giving your name and a description of the page

*Extension: These changes won't make much difference to the way your web page displays in a browser, so what is the point of them?*

3. Modify the page you have created so it looks similar to this:

**Hello World!**

*Extension: Create a couple of other pages and create links to them from your original page. Have these pages open in a separate browser window.*




